

Child Protection Policy

Jay Rosa Academy is fully committed to safeguarding the welfare of all children for which it has a duty of care. It recognises the responsibility to promote safe practice and to protect children of all backgrounds from harm, abuse, and exploitation.

Jay Rosa Academy and other members will work together to respect the rights of children who are members or guests of the academy.

This policy and relevant procedures will be regularly reviewed.

The policy is based on the following principles:

Jay Rosa Academy will:

- 1) Adopt and implement our Child Protection Policy and relevant procedures as necessary.
- 2) Appoint a designated officer and to adopt best practice to safeguard and protect children from abuse and to reduce risk to themselves and other members.
- 3) Support the designated officer to respond to any allegations of misconduct or abuse of children in line with this policy and relevant procedures.
- 4) Regularly monitor and evaluate the implementation of this policy and relevant procedures in accordance with changes in legislation and guidance on the protection of children or following any relevant changes within Jay Rosa Academy.
- 5) Follow any concerns raised about the protection of children within Jay Rosa Academy.

The welfare of children when involved in club activities is the primary concern. Child protection is everyone's responsibility.
